

Pardon Project of York County

Eligibility Criteria

- Residence in York County
- Conviction under Pennsylvania law
- Household income at or below 200% of the federal poverty guideline
- Pardon applicants must have fully completed their period of incarceration and any period of parole or probation, and must not have any open and pending criminal cases.
- You are not eligible if you have any conviction, at any time and in any jurisdiction, for an offense where the conduct of the individual caused or resulted in death or serious bodily injury, or for any sexual offense requiring registration under Pennsylvania's Sex Offender Registration and Notification Act ("SORNA") [42 Pa.C.S. Subchapter H of Chapter 97 in Title 42, Judiciary and Judicial Procedure]]
- Applicants with records of alcohol, mental health or substance abuse problems must demonstrate past and continuing commitment to appropriate treatment programs.
- No open criminal prosecution
- If there are unpaid Legal Financial Obligations (fines, fees, costs) relating to the underlying convictions, the individual is on (or agrees to get on) a repayment plan. Applicants should have fully paid all court-ordered restitution.

The Pardon Project and all of its volunteers reserve the right to decline assistance to any pardon applicant. It will observe and honor all rights afforded to victims under the Crime Victims Act, 18 P.S. § 11.101 et seq. The Pardon Project reserves the right to amend its eligibility criteria at any time.
